

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I subscribe to the St Paul UMC electronic Midweek Reminder?

Send your name and e-mail address to St.Paul.MWR@gmail.com. You will receive a link to the next newsletter.

How will I know when to go look for my new Midweek Reminder information?

The St. Paul UMC Midweek Reminder is a by-weekly newsletter and a new message will arrive in your e-mail inbox as soon as the most recent Midweek Reminder comes out. It should arrive in your e-mail before it would reach your physical mail box.

What should I do if I don't have e-mail?

You don't need to do anything to continue receiving your Midweek Reminder at your physical address. It will continue to be sent to you via USPS unless you tell us to send it via e-mail or to another address.

What should I do if I haven't received my e-MWR?

If you think you have been missed or with other questions about the e-mailing, send an e-mail with your question to St.Paul.MWR@gmail.com. You should receive a response within 24 hours.

You may also access the Midweek on the St. Paul UMC web site -- <http://stpaulomaha.org/>. On the menu on the left side of the St. Paul UMC home page, choose news and events -> newsletter->Midweek Reminder (for the date you want). In this way you can read to the same file.

What if my browser tells me the link may contain viruses or is unsecure?

The link you have been sent is to a page on the web site hosted by St. Paul United Methodist Church in Omaha, Nebraska. It should not be any less safe than going to our web site. If you don't want to click on the Midweek link in the e-mail, you can try the link to the web site -- <http://stpaulomaha.org/>. On the menu on the left side of the St. Paul UMC home page, choose news and events -> newsletter->Midweek Reminder (for the date you want). In this way you can read to the same file.

How do I enlarge the Midweek so that I can read it?

You can enlarge the Midweek Reminder to any size that you need. On the tool bar find the box that holds a percentage (probably 30% or some other percentage). You can type in the percent you want to increase the MWR -- 100% or larger if you want very large print.

What should I do if I don't want to receive the electronic version of the Midweek reminder?

You may receive your copy electronically or via the US Postal Service. For an e-MWR please send an e-mail to St.Paul.MWR@gmail.com. Type in the subject line "please send St Paul e-MWR" and include your name and e-mail address in the body of the e-mail. For a paper copy sent by USPS call 402 556-2433 or send an e-mail to St.Paul.MWR@gmail.com. Type in the subject line "please send St Paul MWR via USPS" and include your name and physical address in the body of the e-mail.

How can I change my e-mail address?

Send an e-mail to St.Paul.MWR@gmail.com. To change your e-mail address, type in the subject line "new e-mail address" and include your name and new e-mail address in the body of your e-mail.

Can I have the midweek sent to more than one e-mail address?

Yes. Send an e-mail to St.Paul.MWR@gmail.com. If you want to add an additional address, please type "please send MWR to additional e-mail address(s)" and include your name and additional e-mail address(s) in the body of your e-mail.

Can I have the midweek sent to someone else?

In order to not "spam" anyone, it is best to have the person to whom you want an MWR sent to request the e-MWR themselves. They may send an e-mail to St.Paul.MWR@gmail.com. Type in the subject line "please send St. Paul e-MWR" and include their name and e-mail address in the body of the e-mail.

How much does a subscription to the St. Paul United Methodist Church Midweek Reminder cost?

There is no charge for the St. Paul United Methodist Church Midweek Reminder. However, donations to St. Paul are always welcome.

Do I have to get the Midweek Reminder via e-mail?
